What will your holidays in 2020 look like at Le Vieil Aiglun?



The world is slowly emerging from one of its most memorable health crises. COVID-19 has not yet completely disappeared, but the development of the pandemic is going in the right direction and the news is reassuring, particularly in the Alpes de Haute-Provence which has been little affected by the virus. However, you probably have some questions about security measures and possible restrictions during your vacation.

Our three holiday cottages are located in a natural environment without neighbourhood. Each cottage has a private space outside. There are also certain areas common to the three cottages (swimming pool, pétanque court, playground and panoramic terrace). All common areas are accessible. Certain restrictions will probably apply (for example, maximum 10 people per common area, privatised "sectors" around the pool), but they will be very light given the layout of the common areas and the reduced capacity of our cottages.

The main constraint concerns your arrival and departure times. In order to be able to ensure a reinforced cleaning, we ask you not to arrive before the end of the afternoon and to respect the departure time when you leave us (10 AM). Please confirm your arrival time by contacting us or by sending a short text message to +33 6 47 72 47 26.

We also recommend that you choose our cleaning package at the end of your stay while respecting a minimum of cleanliness. As a reminder: bed sheets are provided (beds made on arrival) as well as towels. Cleanliness and hygiene have always been our priority and will remain so more than ever.

Remember to carry a face mask during your trips because some shops require the wearing of the mask.

For the rest: the restaurants and cafes have reopened, the markets too (many of them including the Aiglun local market have always remained open), the hiking trails are accessible, most of the sporting activities (via ferrata, adventure park, mountain guiding, etc.) have resumed, the beaches of Lac de Sainte-Croix are gradually reopening, ...
